School Improvements

The interior of our building has improved so much over the last school year. New external doors and a new security system have been installed. Our boiler house has been completely refurbished at considerable expense.

We are continuing with our programme of dry lining in school. During the summer a further 2 classrooms were dry lined.

A fantastic new canopy has been added to our Nursery which will enable our children to get outdoors more regularly for their learning.

We are also planning a new I.C.T. suite and playroom facility and funding for this project has been approved. Work will commence on this soon. All of these improvements have enhanced the Learning Environment for our children and staff.

Musical Pathways

Our Nursery & P1 children are enjoying Musical Pathways programme this year. This is a programme that enables children to develop through music and includes stimulating activities, rhymes songs and games
